Questions & Answers

Q: How do you determine if an organisation has risk identification and mitigation measures in place and how to identify gaps in our risk management plan?

A: Most organisations maintain an enterprise risk register which is regularly reviewed and updated. Such registers identify risk, list mitigation strategies and monitor progress of those strategies. Enterprise risk registers for organisations which operate vehicle fleets should specifically include fleet related risk.

Q: Is there an enterprise risk register tool that is specifically designed for fleet risk available?

A: Save the Children International have recently developed such a tool which could be made available through Fleet Forum to other organisations.

Q: What do we consider to be the principal fleet specific enterprise risks faced by organizations in the aid and development sector?

A: There are many and they can vary between organisations and subject to the conditions in which they work. However, the most common include, but are not limited to: road safety, security, legal and reputational, cost and asset control, misappropriation, compliance and working through partners.

Q: Are there any trainings available specifically on the subject of identifying and managing vehicle fleet related enterprise risk for aid and development organisations?

A: We are not aware of any such trainings available at this time. It is something that Fleet Forum will investigate and consider developing in the future. We will update you if this idea is taken forward.
